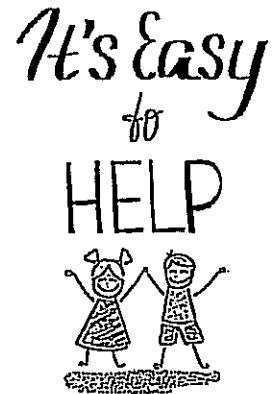

HELPFUL NOTES:

Students Arriving Late:

If you are bringing your child to school after 9:45 AM you must bring your child to the office and sign him/her in. Your child will be marked tardy if he/she is not in the classroom at 9:45 AM. Also, we ask that you leave your child at the office and not accompany him/her to the classroom because it is disruptive to the start of the day. Remember that the classroom is for all students' learning, not just one.

Pick Up at Day's End:

If you are picking your child up at day's end, we ask that you meet him/her in the parking lot on 16th and University no later than 4:30 PM. We ask that you PLEASE do not wait outside the classroom door, as it is disruptive to the end of day routine.

When sending money to school with a student:

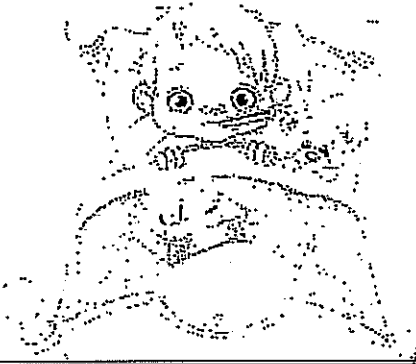
Please send separate checks with the name of the student and a note as to what the money is for (i.e. Tuition, Field Trip, etc.)

In case of illness:

If your child is ill it is important that he/she remain at home.

Your child must be SYMPTOM & FEVER FREE for 24 hours WITHOUT medicine before returning to school.

Sick children will be sent home. If your child is ill, please call the school and let us know. If he/she is out for more than 3 days, you must bring a doctor's note upon his/her return. ~~You must contact the school office by 10:15 AM to report your child's absence, or it will be considered *unexcused*.~~
